## **Passport, Medical Insurance card, Emergency/Medical Travel Insurance Coverage**

Make two (2) copies of passport page with picture on it and two (2) copies front and back of medical insurance cards (Medicare/Supplemental Insurance) and a copy of your Emergency/Medical Travel Insurance coverage - keep one (1) of each for yourself and return one of each to PFWBC Holyland Tour by August 15 , 2020) - **PASSPORT must be valid for a minimum of six (6) months after your date of return (December 9, 2020) from Israel, as required by Israel.**

**Tour Registrations** received after August 15 are considered late registrations and will incur a late fee of \$100 per passenger. Tour must be paid in full at time of late registration made after August 15 , 2020 at a cost of \$2888 per person double occupancy or at a cost of \$3378 per person single occupancy.

## **CANCELLATION PENALTIES** for any reason:

**\$200** 90 - 76 days before departure (September 2 - September 16)

**\$350** 75 - 61 days before departure (September 17 - October 1)

**25% of tour price** 60 - 46 days before departure (October 2 -16)

**50% of tour price** 45 - 31 days before departure (October 17 - 31)

**100% of tour price** 30 days or less before departure (November 1)

## **AIR MILES CANNOT BE USED FOR GROUP TRAVEL.**

**DOMESTIC FLIGHTS** to and from the international departure airport (Newark, New Jersey) are not included in the tour package and are the responsibility of each tour member. International flight times can change. You will need to arrive at Newark Airport 3½ - 4 hours before the international flight departure time. Details for the international flight will be sent after final tour payment.

If domestic travel is booked more than 60 days in advance of departure date you are encouraged to purchase a flexible ticket which allows for no charge or minimal charge for flight changes.

**PRICE** is \$2788 per person based on double occupancy. Single occupancy rate is \$3278 per person.

**REGISTRATION** Registration Form and a deposit of \$500 per person are to be mailed to PFWBC Holyland Tour, PO Box 39, Pittsburg, IL 62974 to confirm your reservation or you may make your reservation on line at: [www.pittsburgfwb.org](http://www.pittsburgfwb.org) and then mail your \$500 deposit within one week.

**BALANCE** is due in full by August 15, 2020. Final payments after this deadline will be assessed a \$100 per passenger late payment fee. All reservations not fully paid by the deadline are subject to cancellation.

**PAYMENT** by or for an individual affirms your agreement to these terms and conditions. Payment is to be made by check or money order payable to **PFWBC Holyland Tour**.

**PASSPORT** must be valid for a minimum of six-months after your date of return (December 9, 2020) from Israel, as required by Israel. (For US citizens, no visa is required by Israel). A copy of your passport must be received by PFWBC Holyland Tour by August 15, 2020.

**PROOF OF MEDICAL INSURANCE and EMERGENCY/MEDICAL TRAVEL INSURANCE** A (copy) of the front and back of your health insurance cards (Medicare/Supplemental) and a (copy) of your Emergency/Medical Travel Insurance proof of coverage or waiver are required along with a (copy) of your passport by August 15, 2020.

**TRANSPORTATION** is by modern air-conditioned motor coach and by EL AL Israel Airlines, economy class seating. Airline tickets must be completed 30 days prior to departure and cannot be changed once issued. Upgrades and cost are the sole responsibility of the passenger after ticketing

**DEVIATIONS/STOPOVERS, or any** individual change in the return date that is a deviation from the basic group itinerary will **NOT** be allowed.

**HOTELS** are based on two persons/double occupancy room with private bath. Single rooms are subject to availability for an additional cost of \$490. **If a tour member does not have a roommate and PFWBC Holyland Tours is unable to find one for you, or your roommate cancels before departure, you will have to pay the single supplemental charge of an additional \$490.**

**MEALS** are on half board (HB); two meals daily - breakfast and dinner at hotel with full Israeli buffet - first day in Israel only dinner meal included at hotel and on last day in Israel only breakfast included. - other meals include St. Peter's Fish lunch by the Sea of Galilee and on last day a Farewell Dinner . The cost of lunch is the responsibility of each tour member. Cost is approximately \$12-\$16.

**SIGHTSEEING** is by deluxe air-conditioned motor coach. The services of an English speaking, local Israeli tour escort and entrance fees to all sites as stated in the itinerary are included in the tour price. The daily itinerary is subject to change at the discretion of the tour operator/escort or their representative as necessary dependent on weather conditions, road conditions, traffic, etc.

**AUDIO AND VISUAL RELEASE** Tour registration gives authorization for you to be photographed and/or audio/video recorded and releases Tour Operator, Tour Host, and their agents from liability, conditions, restrictions, or compensation of any kind from obtaining and using these photographs and/or audio/video recordings.

**PHYSICAL NEEDS:** Each tour member must be able to walk, get on and off the motor coach, go up and down stairs, walk on uneven terrain, and be able to get around without additional assistance. Any tour member needing additional assistance must bring someone, at their own expense, to assist them.

**NOT INCLUDED:** Passport costs; food and beverages (including coffee, tea, and soft drinks) not usually included with meals; optional tours and excursions not mentioned in this itinerary; trip cancellation-emergency medical/accidental and luggage insurance; transporting and handling luggage except at Israeli Hotels; and additional gratuities of a personal nature. Gratuities are already included for tour escort, driver, hotel staff, and Farewell Dinner.
